Review FAS for training opportunities and manage training bunk allocation

**Review and manage Fleet availability to include training periods and training bunks are managed to maximise SQEP achievement.**

### Benefits

- New and adhoc training opportunities are reported through the Fleet Training Working Group.
- Force training requirements such as Plan METEOR are routinely included in FAS.
- Exercise planning and delivery have been aligned to meet training requirements within each exercise, EXKA22 was the first example of this concept.
- In SURFOR, training Bunks management has been improved through the establishment of a centralised Training / Sea Experience Bunk Management portal in SURFOR SharePoint. This allows external organisation to better forecast longer term availability.
- CSRG North under PB Group have developed a management plan for training bunks with the focus on platform endorsements/experience for readying personnel.
