Providing Flexible Infrastructure and Locations

Defence is adopting a new way of working known as Activity-based work (ABW). Work is no longer viewed as a place but as an activity to obtain an outcome. Some of the features of ABW include:

- open plan individual work areas made up of a typical modular furniture with appropriate ICT connectivity;
- enclosed interchangeable spaces such as offices, meeting rooms, conference rooms and retreat/quiet rooms;
- workplace facilities are shared within a neighbourhood;
- team collaboration areas comprising typical furniture suited to enable quick collaborative meetings and discussions; and
- support amenities to the main office function such as lounge, breakout spaces, kitchen facilities, storage and circulation space etc.

Three locations completed;

- R1-6-SLG Drop in Hub, 25 Catalina Drive Majura,
- 320 Pitt Street Sydney, and
- Defence Plaza Melbourne is currently undergoing a major renovation.
