Ways of Working Implement Critical Category Remediation Plans

The Navy monitors the workforce health of all categories and for all identified critical categories a remediation plan is developed, implemented and monitored.

A critical category is an indicator of Force-in-being shortfalls that could severely limit Defences mission.

Benefits

- Annual review of critical categories through Chiefs of Service Committee (COSC) ensures regular updating.
- 5 areas are utilised to assess critical categories; 12 months' strength trend, entries, separations, training and force structure.
- The remediation actions link directly to these areas for clear allocation of responsible group/person.
- Critical category remediation plans are available for all Defence members to view.
- FNW workgroup planners provide updates during roadshows and in workgroup advisory group meetings.
