Benefits

To ensure we continue to support you and your family to maintain a healthy lifestyle and to access affordable healthcare, The ADF Family Benefit Program will see two major changes.

- From 15 December 2022, additional services will be available for reimbursements under the Program. These additions include services to reduce tobacco use, vaccinations, ambulance cover and reimbursements on pharmaceuticals.
- From 1 July 2023, the allowance will double from \$400 to \$800 per dependant per year. Reimbursable services will further expand and are expected to include services for healthy diets, increasing physical activity, cancer screening and reducing alcohol and drug related harm.

Important Information

It is important to note the additional per dependant allocation will affect member's Fringe Benefits Tax reporting. For further information on how this affects you and your family, speak to your ADF Financial Services Consumer Council representative, your tax agent or your accountant.
