- Greater flexibility to study anytime and anywhere.
- More opportunities to improve general skills and professional development.

More Information

- In 2022, 456 sailors and 335 officers have received sponsorship for part-time study.
- Whilst role-relevant courses are prioritised, out of category education options are also available under DASS, ADFA PG and Civil Schooling.
- The number of applications funded has increased by 11% since 2020.

Future Activities

- Explore opportunities for Navy to standardise work release for study purposes.
- Revise application forms and processes to remove unnecessary administration.
- Review the feasibility of using via MyFi/Reimburse Me app for study reimbursements.
