- This initiative is closely aligned with the introduction of the Workforce Generation System which will see personnel undertaking most of their future training in the Reading Phase via a CSRG.
- The TFP26 PMO and TFHQ staff are also working on the sequencing and resourcing of TFP26 activities for the FY22/23. Once this work is completed you will see more detailed information on our transformation goals and activities for the next 12 months. In the meantime, transformation activities already underway are continuing as resources allow. It has been particularly pleasing to see progress in many different areas of transformation such as the ongoing changes to TFHQ, the movement of training to where our people work and live, the integration of the Navy Training Planning System with the Workforce Generation System and the work being done on our infrastructure planning and the first Mariner Mastery Centre that is planned for Darwin.
